



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
*Between*  
**CONSULT AUSTRALIA**  
*And*  
**AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF PROJECT MANAGEMENT**  
**June 2016**

***In recognition of the ongoing co-operation between Consult Australia and the Australian Institute of Project Management (AIPM), this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) identifies synergies and a non exhaustive list of shared objectives between the two organisations, and provides a platform for joint co-operation and representation.***

***Consult Australia*** is the industry association for professional services firms within the built and natural environment; influencing policy, creating value and promoting excellence. Consult Australia represents member firms' business interests at a commercial, community, industry and government level through collaboration, education, support and advocacy.

The ***Australian Institute of Project Management*** is the professional association for project managers consisting of over 10,000 members across Australia and overseas. It exists to:

- *advance the interests of members, their professional standards and contemporary practice, and*
- *expand and advocate the value of project managers and project management to the sustainable growth of our community, economy and culture.*

**The two organisations hereby agree:**

- All reasonable efforts will be made to ensure access to enable an open and efficient dialogue between AIPM and Consult Australia. Both organisations will respect confidentiality in discussions, and to not take advantage of knowledge of the other's position. Where matters are not agreed upon, each organisation will respect the right of the other to maintain its views, and in doing so will not prejudice the cooperation which may continue more broadly.
- Exchange relevant data and research, and to promote in a collaborative fashion, their respective missions.
- Cooperative arrangements will be adopted on advocacy issues relevant to our respective members and constituents, including providing prior notice to each other on relevant releases; ideally mutual and complementary positions and appropriate cross-reference to the other for media purposes.
- Extend invitations to members and constituents on a reciprocal and reasonable basis to each other's luncheons/seminars/events relating to infrastructure.
- Include each other on public information/circular publication/newsletter circulation lists.
- Profile each other's organisation on their respective websites (via hotlink).
- This MOU can be terminated by either party with one month's written notice.
