## Changes to policies, procedures and legislative instruments

- QLD Transport and Main Roads Joint launch of the industry culture initiative.
- WA Premier Smoothing of the pipeline of projects.
- QLD Energy & Public Works Government Guidance on Insurance Requirements The guide was modified to reduce the set insurance levels.
- QLD Energy & Public Works Government Best Practice Principles Design and engineering work is exempt from the application of the best practice principles, where contracted separate to construction.
- NSW Design and Building Practitioner Regulations one year moratorium on insurance requirements.

#### **Engagement with government departments, agencies and clients**

- QLD Transport and Main Roads We joined the TMR Collaborative Taskforce to drive the development of TMR's Collaborative Procurement and Delivery Model.
- NT Power Water Corporation We established a quarterly roundtable to discuss procurement models and timely delivery of projects.
- QLD Moreton Bay Regional Council We established a good relationship and ongoing engagement to discuss procurement reform, insurance and contract changes.
- TAS Infrastructure Tasmania We established monthly meetings by mutual agreement. Topics covered include procurement and contracting.
- TAS TasWater We established regular forums with TasWater to work through challenges of the contracts.
- SA Department of Treasury & Finance Industry Advisory Group Jan was invited to the newly
  established advisory group to bring a closer relationship between government and industry within the
  context of SA procurement activities.
- QLD Gold Coast Council We established ongoing contact with Gold Coast Council with a contract workshop scheduled for early 2022.
- QLD Energy & Public Works We have established a positive working relationship with EPW and are currently working on re-engagement on the insurance/liability issues of the AS4122 Special Conditions.
- NSW Transport for NSW We are in constant contact with TfNSW to ensure we get a say on Project Streamline.
- NSW Treasury We are in constant contact with Treasury to ensure we get a say on their commercial conditions (aka capped fees) and contract workstreams

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• WA – Department of Small Business Commission – We established a very positive working relationship with who is keen to engage further with us on insurance and de-risking the market – including getting a joint meeting with WA Treasury.
