# Consult Australia supports the strengthening of the Government's decision-making framework

Consult Australia supports evidence-based decision making and therefore welcomes the announcement by the Hon. Ben Morton MP, Assistant Minister to the Prime Minister and Cabinet on strengthening the Government's decision-making settings. The acknowledgement that regulatory impact extends beyond financial is a long time coming.

Consult Australia represents businesses in design, advisory, and engineering, an industry comprising some 48,000 firms across Australia that employ around 240,000 people. Consult Australia is the only association representing the business community in our sector.

The regulatory impact analysis framework is a vital tool that, when used in a consultative way, can ensure that new reforms are not just additional red tape, but are real reforms that balance the needs of the community with productivity in industry.

Nicola Grayson, Chief Executive of Consult Australia, said, "We support the framework being updated to ensure that a regulatory impact statement (RIS) is required when the reform is likely to lead to measurable changes in the behaviour of businesses or individuals."

"Industry associations, such as Consult Australia, are always willing to work collaboratively with governments to ensure better regulation, rather than just more regulation. We are encouraged to see the use of a Consultation RIS process at the Federal level, allowing industry knowledge to be fed into the process earlier."

"We call on state and territory governments to commit to similar reforms, including the use of a Consultation RIS process."
