Virtual roundtable request - Building and Infrastructure Pipeline re COVID-19

I am writing on behalf of Consult Australia member firms to commend the Australian Government's actions to date in response to the significant economic consequences of COVID-19, and to seek your engagement regarding the ongoing delivery of building and infrastructure projects and COVID-19 safety measures.
